MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN

In terms of Section 28 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended) promulgated under the National Environmental Management Act – NEMA (Act No. 107 of 1998), a Maintenance Management Plan (MMP) will be followed for the Proposed upgrade the IRPTN Line 3 Operations Prince's Park and Bus Stops Bay along WF Nkomo Street, Pretoria within the jurisdiction of the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality. The application will be submitted to Gauteng Department of Environment (GDEnv).

PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS AND LOCATION:

City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality (applicant) intends to upgrade the IRPTN Line 3 Operations Prince's Park and Bus Stops Bay along WF Nkomo Street, Pretoria. Project activities included Rehabilitation and Replacement of Stormwater Pipelines wherein there was a coordination of discharge area for Stormwater line which included installation of a 525mm diameter pipe over a distance of approximately 57m, and associated manhole works in proximity to the watercourse. The proposed study area can be accessed through W.F. Nkomo Street (formerly known as Church Street) and Prince Park Street. The coordinates to the site are **25°45'5.39"S 28°10'41.91"E**.
